Officers' Reports

President

1. SCMSOA conducted virtual membership and board meetings during the COVID-19 pandemic. The association purchased a Zoom license to meet current and future needs.
2. Lime Valley Advertising rebuilt SCMSOA's website and transferred it to a more secure host.
3. Elections for President and Secretary are due this fall.

Treasurer

1. Finances as of October 5, 2020:
 - Income = \$378.75
 - Expenses = \$1,851.41
 - Checking account balance = \$4,778.72
2. SCMSOA's income is directly related to the number of games for which the association supplies officials. COVID-19 resulted in fewer games compared with recent years so income for 2020 will be lower.
3. Expenses also have been lower. Virtual meetings have saved money compared with in-person gatherings and there were fewer new members than in recent years, reducing the need for mentoring.

Charter Clinician

1. SCMSOA continues to meet the Minnesota State High School League's stringent requirements for Legacy Association status.
2. SCMSOA participated in the statewide MSHSL Officials Recruitment Forum, a virtual event held via Zoom on June 23, 2020. The association also contacted colleges and universities in the area to recruit new members.
3. To date, no outbreaks of the virus have been attributed to high school soccer matches. Thanks to members for following COVID-19 protocols.
